Varietals	Syrah, Carignan, Grenache, Mourvèdre
Appellation/Area	Faugères AOC
Vineyard Locations	On the cooler hillsides of Faugères, 30 km away from the Mediterranean Sea.
Soils	Schistes only, one of the most ancient soil
Yields	4 000 to 4 500 vine stocks per hectare.
Vinification	Vinification by parcel in order to select the best grapes Long maceration of destemmed grapes, with controlled temperature. We use the Burgundy method of pigeage
No Oak	Aged in stainless steel vats.
Alcohol	13 %

Tasting notes / Food Pairing

Very expressive notes of red fruit aromas providing generosity and immediate pleasure. It is very ripe and already enjoyable ; The tannins are very well covered. This crispy, lively wine could age for another 3-4 years. This wine has the terroir excitement of the Schistes : a strong personality, without heaviness, crispy, lively and very fruity. We suggest to drink it with mushroom risotto, bird game, or coq au vin.
