This outstanding property is situated in the heart of Minervois. The vines of Fabas are growing on soft slopes orientated South, on the warm side of the Minervois. Château Fabas produces wines showing elegance and finesse with fine and spicy aromas, notes of ripe black fruit, quite typical for this chalk and sandstone terroir, that perfectly match to meals where their aromas are developing best.

Details for the Cuvée LES SERBOLLES

Terroir Chalk and sandstone terroir
Varietals 30 % Syrah, 40% Grenache,
 20% Very old Mourvèdre (35 to 55 year old), 10% Carignan
No oak

Tasting notes

The wine itself shows outstanding raspberry, jammy fruit with fresh berry fruit, plums, cherries and blackcurrant flavours on the palate with mineral and smoky touches lead into a luxuriously spicy, well-balanced finish.

Food Pairing

This well structured, full flavoured product is a wine of breed and character enhanced by the qualities of its soil, an ideal companion to explore the Minervois sunny region. Should be kept three to four years.
